IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend the law relating to political caucuses in the city of Bangor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Section two of chapter four hundred and seven 2 of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred seven 3 is hereby amended by adding after the words at the end of 4 said section the following: "At the August session of each 5 year as herein provided," so that said section as amended 6 shall read as follows:

'Section 2. After the board of registration shall have made 8 the list of voters for the year nineteen hundred and seven 9 with the party designation as provided in section three of said act, such party designation shall remain the same on that list and the lists for subsequent years unless a voter in person or in writing signed by him, shall request his party designation to be changed at the August session of each year as the herein provided.'
