IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend the law relating to political caucuses in the  
city of Bangor.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section two of chapter four hundred and seven  
2 of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred seven  
3 is hereby amended by adding after the words at the end of  
4 said section the following: "At the August session of each  
5 year as herein provided," so that said section as amended  
6 shall read as follows:

'Section 2. After the board of registration shall have made  
8 the list of voters for the year nineteen hundred and seven  
9 with the party designation as provided in section three of

10 said act, such party designation shall remain the same on that  
11 list and the lists for subsequent years unless a voter in per-  
12 son or in writing signed by him, shall request his party desig-  
13 nation to be changed at the August session of each year as  
14 herein provided.'
