STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Camden and Augusta
Railway.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Cam-
2 den and Augusta Railway which were granted by chapter
3 seventy-five of the Private and Special Laws of one thousand
4 nine hundred and three, as amended by chapter three hun-
5 dred and forty-three of the Private and Special Laws of one
6 thousand nine hundred and seven, are hereby extended for
7 two years from the time when this act shall take effect, and
8 the parties named in said act and said amendment thereto,
9 their associates, successors and assigns, shall have all the

10 rights, powers and privileges that were granted by said chap-
11 ter seventy-five of the Private and Special Laws of one thou-
12 sand nine hundred and three as amended by said chapter
13 three hundred and forty-three of the Private and Special
14 Laws of one thousand nine hundred and seven.
