STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter seventy-seven of the Public Laws of
nineteen hundred five, relating to sea and shore fisheries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section three of chapter seventy-seven of the
2 public laws of nineteen hundred and five is hereby amended
3 by striking out in the sixth, seventh and eighth lines "treas-
4 urer of the county in which the proceedings are commenced
5 and by said treasurer" and inserting in place thereof 'com-
6 missioner of sea and shore fisheries, and by said commis-
7 sioner of sea and shore fisheries,' so that said section when
8 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 3. The penalty provided for by the preceding sec-
10 tion may be recovered in the county where the offense is

11 committed, by complaint, indictment or action of debt
12 brought in the name of the person making the complaint;
13 and all fines and penalties recovered by this act shall go,
14 one-half to the person making the complaint, and the other
15 half to the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries, and by
16 said commissioner of sea and shore fisheries paid to the
17 State treasurer to be added to, and made a part of the appro-
18 priation for sea and shore fisheries.'
