STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to provide for a close time on wild animals and birds
on Kineo point, so-called, Moosehead Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person at any
2 time to hunt, pursue, shoot at or kill any wild animal or bird
3 on Kineo point, so called, and for the purposes of this act
4 Kineo point shall be construed to mean all the lands lying
5 south of the top of Mount Kineo and extending to the Pa-
6 vilion at North Bay, so-called. Whoever violates any of
7 the provisions of this act shall be subject to a penalty of
8 fifty dollars and costs for each offense.

Sect. 2. Municipal and police judges and trial justices
2 in their respective counties shall have original and concur-
3 rent jurisdiction with the supreme and superior courts in all
4 offenses arising under this act.
