RESOLVE, in aid of bridge across the Aroostook River in the
town of Masardis in Aroostook County.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum
2 of six thousand dollars in aid of a bridge across the Aroos-
3 took River at the Cameron Crossing, so-called, in the town
4 of Masardis in Aroostook County, said sum to be disposed
5 of under the direction of the selectmen of said town of
6 Masardis, provided it does not exceed two-thirds the cost of
7 the bridge.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The valuation of the town, 1908,	\$135,655 00
Rate of percent, 3%,	
Total indebtedness,	<u>7,755 20</u>
The estimated cost of bridge,	10,200 00
Estimated cost of approaches,	<u>1,000 00</u>
Total cost of bridge,	\$11,200 00

In view of the fact that the town has exceeded its 5% limit, the amount of \$6000 as asked for in the accompanying resolve is necessary to enable said town to erect a bridge at this time.
