IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 412 of the Private and Special Laws of 1907, regulating fishing in Swift river in the counties of Oxford and Franklin.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 412 of the Private and  
2 Special Laws of 1907 is hereby amended as follows: By in-  
3 serting the words 'including Swift river pond' between  
4 the word "Franklin" and the word "except" in the fifth line  
5 of Section 1, and also by striking out the words "Wednes-  
6 day and Friday" in the seventh line of said section 1, and  
7 inserting the words 'Monday and Tuesday,' in place thereof,  
8 and also by striking out the tenth, eleventh, twelfth, thir-  
9 tenth and fourteenth lines of said section, so that said sec-  
10 tion as amended shall read as follows:

‘Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or  
12 kill any kind of fish at any time in Swift river, so called, or  
13 in any of the streams, tributary thereto, situated in Rum-  
14 ford, Mexico, Roxbury, Byron and Plantations D and E,  
15 in the counties of Oxford and Franklin, including Swift  
16 river pond, except that it shall be lawful to fish in accord-  
17 ance with the general laws of the State in the river itself and  
18 in any of its tributaries on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and  
19 Saturday of each week during the month of May, June and  
20 July of each year. And no person shall catch, take or kill  
21 over thirty-five fish of lawful size in any one day from any  
22 or all of these waters, under a penalty of one dollar for each  
23 and every fish caught or killed in excess of said thirty-five.’

Sect. 2. In all prosecutions under this chapter, municipal  
2 and police courts and trial justices, within their respective  
3 counties, shall have, upon complaint, original and concur-  
4 rent jurisdiction with the supreme and superior courts.
