STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Brown brook and Perry pond
and tributaries, in Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish at any time in Brown brook or in Perry
3 pond, or any of the tributaries to said Perry pond, which
4 waters are situated wholly or partly in the town of Harmony,
5 Somerset County, except on Tuesday and Friday of each
6 week, during the open season provided by the general law
7 of the State.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the

3 general law of the State for the illegal fishing for and catch-
4 ing trout and land-locked salmon.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions under this chapter, municipal
2 and police courts and trial justices within their respective
3 counties shall have original and concurrent jurisdiction with
4 the supreme and superior courts.
