IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to prohibit ice fishing in the Puffer ponds, so-called,  
in the town of Dexter, Penobscot county.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or  
2 kill any kind of fish at any time through the ice in the Puffer  
3 ponds, so-called, in the town of Dexter, County of Penob-  
4 scot, under the same penalty as is provided in the general  
5 law of the State for the illegal fishing for and catching trout  
6 and land-locked salmon.

Sect. 2. In all prosecutions arising under this chapter, mu-  
2 nicipal and police courts and trial justices within their re-  
3 spective counties shall have, upon complaint, original and  
4 concurrent jurisdiction with the supreme and superior  
5 courts.
