STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in the waters in Alder stream
township, in the County of Franklin.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to take,
2 catch or kill more than ten trout in all in any one day in any
3 of the waters in Alder Stream township, in the County of
4 Franklin.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the
3 general law of the State for the illegal fishing for and catch-
4 ing trout and land-locked salmon.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions under this chapter, municipal
2 and police courts and trial justices, within their respective
3 counties, shall have, upon complaint, original and concur-
4 rent jurisdiction with the supreme and superior courts.
