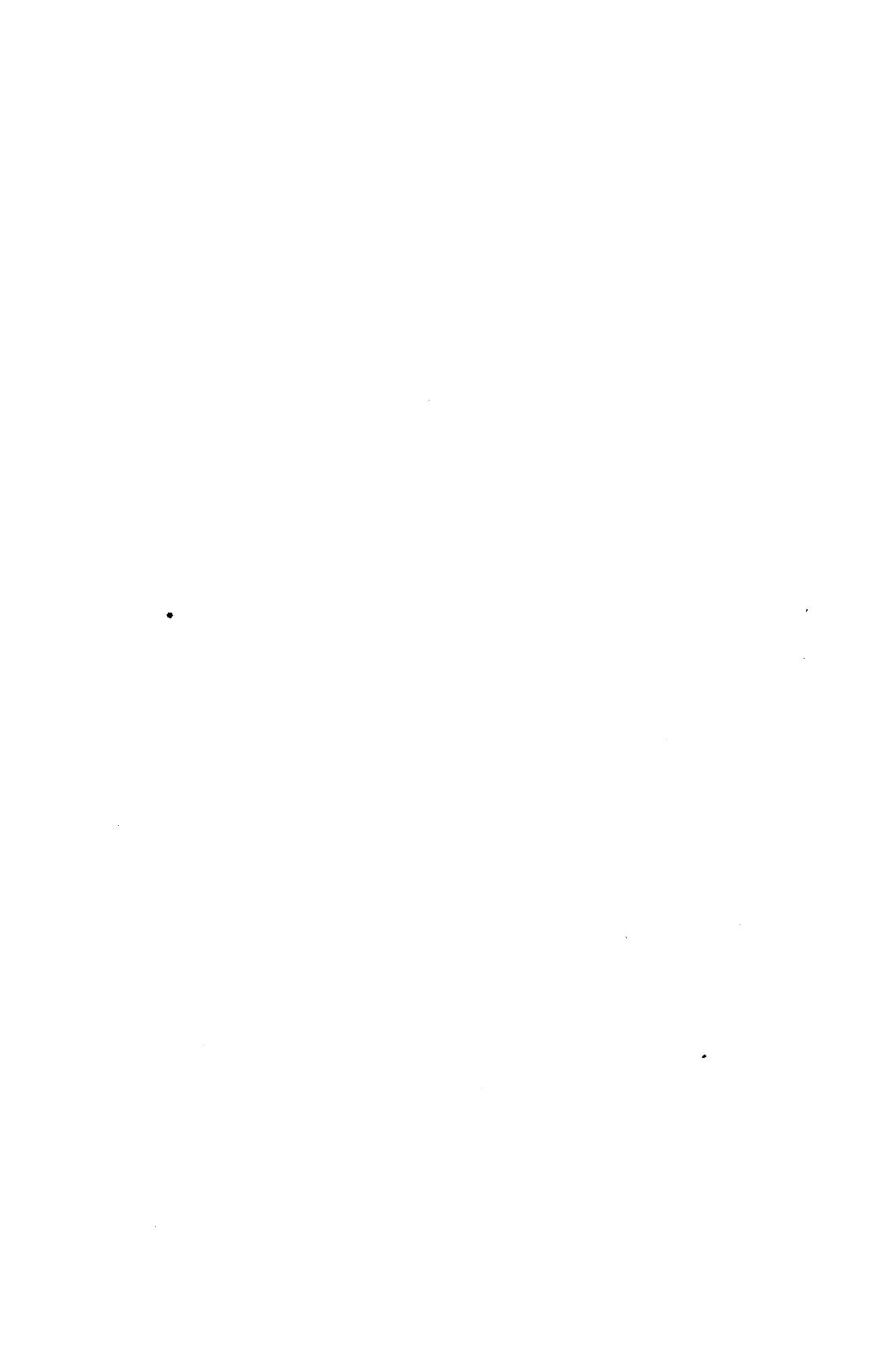

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of the Maine State Pomological Society.

Whereas, the question of better fruit for Maine is of the greatest importance to our State welfare, now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum
2 of one thousand dollars annually, to be paid to the Maine
3 State Pomological Society, this amount to be used by the
4 society for the purpose of promoting the interests of better
5 fruit growing in Maine, by holding an annual exhibition
6 wherein premiums on horticultural products shall be paid,
7 and such field meetings as may be thought profitable by the
8 executive committee, and for the payment of any other in-
9 cidental expenses thereof; provided, that an itemized ac-
10 count of all moneys expended be rendered each year to the
11 Commissioner of Agriculture, and upon his approval and
12 the presentation of proper vouchers, said appropriation shall
13 be paid from the State treasury.
