IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT additional to and amendatory of Chapter 424 of the Private and Special Laws of 1907, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Kittery Water District within the limits of the town of Kittery for the purpose of supplying the inhabitants of said district, likewise the remaining portion of said town, with pure water for domestic and municipal purposes."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Kittery Water District is hereby author-2 ized and empowered to extend its business into the town of 3 Eliot for the purpose of supplying the said town of Eliot

4 and the inhabitants thereof with water for domestic and

5 municipal purposes.

- Sect. 2. Said Kittery Water District is hereby given and 2 granted the same authority, rights and privileges to install, 3 transact and carry on its business in said town of Eliot as it 4 has in the town of Kittery as set forth in its act of incorposition.
- Sect. 3. For accomplishing the purposes of this act, said 2 Kittery Water District, through its trustees, is authorized 3 to issue its notes or bonds to an amount sufficient to procure 4 funds to pay the expenses necessary to install its business 5 in said town of Eliot.
