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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT to amend the charter of the trustees of Hebron  
Academy.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The charter of the trustees of Hebron Acad-  
2 emy, in regard to the term of office of the trustees is hereby  
3 amended so as to read as follows:

The number of trustees shall be fifteen—their term of  
5 office shall be three years, except as otherwise provided  
6 herein. The trustees shall be elected in classes of five  
7 each, namely—Class Number 1, Class Number 2, and Class  
8 Number 3.

At the annual meeting in June, 1909, five trustees shall  
10 be elected to hold office for three years, to be denominated

11 Class Number 1, and the five trustees so elected shall take  
12 the place of the first five trustees now on the printed list as  
13 published by the academy, whose term shall expire by virtue  
14 of this act upon the election of their successors as above  
15 provided.

At the annual meeting in June, 1910, five trustees shall  
17 be elected to hold office for three years, to be denominated  
18 Class Number 2, and the five trustees so elected shall take  
19 the place of the second five trustees in the printed list as  
20 published by the academy, whose term shall expire upon  
21 the election of their successors.

At the annual meeting in June, 1911, five trustees shall  
23 be elected to hold office for three years, to be denominated  
24 Class Number 3, and the five trustees so elected shall take  
25 the place of the last five trustees now on the printed list as  
26 published by the academy, whose term shall expire upon  
27 the election of their successors.

On and after the annual meeting in June, 1912, five trus-  
29 tees shall be elected each year, commencing with Class  
30 Number 1, to fill the vacancies caused by the expiration of  
31 the term of office of the various classes.

Any vacancy that may occur in the Board shall be filled  
33 by the election of some person to hold office for the unex-  
34 pired term of the trustee causing the vacancy.
