IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Eastport Street Railway
Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the East-
2 port Street Railway Company which were granted by chap-
3 ter four hundred and sixty-five of the private and special
4 laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, and extended
5 by chapter one hundred and seventeen of the private and
6 special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, and fur-
7 ther extended by chapter two hundred and sixty-eight of
8 the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and one,
9 and further extended by chapter two hundred and sixty-
10 four of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred

11 and three, and further extended by chapter one hundred
12 and thirteen of the private and special laws of nineteen
13 hundred and five and further extended by chapter two hun-
14 dred and twenty-five of the private and special laws of
15 nineteen hundred and seven, are hereby further extended
16 for and during the period of two years from the seven-
17 tenth day of March, nineteen hundred and nine, and all
18 the rights, powers and privileges that were granted and
19 acquired by virtue of or under said acts may and shall be
20 exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes
21 as provided in said chapter four hundred and sixty-five.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the sixteenth day
2 of March, nineteen hundred and nine.
