STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of the town of Millinocket.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of One Thousand Dollars; Five Hundred in the year 3 Nineteen Hundred and Nine; and Five Hundred dollars in 4 the year Nineteen Hundred and Ten; to aid in repairing 5 the road leading from Millinocket in Penobscot County, 6 through the North half of Indian Purchase III and the 7 South half of No. I, Range 8 to Millinocket Lake; pro-8 vided the town of Millinocket spends a like amount. The 9 same to be expended under the direction of an agent to be 10 appointed for that purpose by the Governor and Council.
