STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of the Lee Normal Academy.

Resolved: That the sum of one thousand dollars is hereby 2 annually appropriated, for the term of two years, out of 3 the school fund, to Lee Normal Academy, an institution of 4 learning located in the town of Lee, in the county of Penob-5, scot; provided, however, that this appropriation is made 6 on the express conditions that the trustees of said institu-7 tion shall maintain and keep in operation a school equal in 8 rank and grade of teaching with a first class academy and 9 in which shall be given special and systematic instruction 10 in the science and art of teaching; that no part of this ap-11 propriation shall be devoted to other purposes than the 12 payment of instructors in said institution; that the superin-13 tendent of public schools shall be, ex-officio, a member of 14 the board of directors thereof, and that if in the opinion of 15 the Governor and Council, said institution at any time here-

16 after shall fail to fulfil the conditions contained in this re17 solve, they may, in their discretion, withhold the appropria18 tion herein granted; and the further sum of fifteen hundred
19 dollars is hereby appropriated to said academy to be ex20 pended by the trustees thereof for the payment of the debt
21 incurred by the erection of the dormitory connected with
22 said institution; and, further, provided, that said Normal
23 Academy shall not be entitled to any aid from the State for
24 the years nineteen hundred nine and nineteen hundred ten
25 in addition to that carried by this resolve.
