IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate ice fishing in Thomas pond, Cumberland
County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. So much of section 1 of chapter 407 of the
2 private and special laws of 1903, as prohibits fishing through
3 the ice, in accordance with the general law of the state, in
4 Thomas pond, in Raymond and Casco, in Cumberland
5 County, on the last three days of the first week of March
6 following the first Sunday in March, in each year, is hereby
7 repealed.
