IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the open season on deer in the towns of
Unity and Burnham in the County of Waldo.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. In addition to the open season on deer now
2 provided by law in the towns of Unity and Burnham, in the
3 County of Waldo, it shall be lawful to hunt, chase, catch,
4 kill and destroy deer, in accordance with the general law of
5 the State, in said towns from December first to December
6 fifteenth of each year.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act
2 are hereby repealed.
