IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend section 2 of chapter 407 of the private and special laws of 1903, relating to fishing in the tributaries to Brettun's pond, in Livermore, in Androscoggin county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. So much of section 2 of chapter 407 of the private and special laws of 1903, as prohibits fishing, in accordance with the general law of the State, in the tributaries to Brettun's pond, which pond is situated in the town of Livermore, in Androscoggin County, is hereby repealed.
