STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT authorizing the town of Rumford in the county of
Oxford to subscribe for stock or bonds for the purpose of
securing a town hall to be used for municipal purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The inhabitants of the town of Rumford in the
2 county of Oxford, may at any legal meeting, authorize and
3 empower its municipal officers to subscribe for and take
4 stock or bonds to the amount of not exceeding thirty thou-
5 sand dollars in any corporation owning or which may own
6 a building in said town to be used in part for town meetings
7 and other municipal purposes.

Sect. 2. The said municipal officers of said town for the
2 purpose of raising said sum and for paying for said stock

3 or bonds, may if authorized by vote of said town at a legal
4 meeting issue negotiable notes or bonds of said town for the
5 whole or any part of said sum in such denomination and at
6 such rate of interest as they may determine and may sell and
7 dispose of the same or if directed by vote at said legal meet-
8 ing, the whole of any part of such sum may be appropriated
9 and raised by taxation.
