AN ACT to amend section one of chapter 407 of the private and special laws of 1903, relating to fishing through the ice in Grassy pond, in the towns of Hope and Rockport, in Knox county.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. So much of section one of chapter 407 of the  
2 private and special laws of 1903, as prohibits fishing through  
3 the ice, in accordance with the general law of the State, on  
4 Tuesday and Saturday of each week, in Grassy pond, so-  
5 called, in the towns of Hope and Rockport, in Knox county,  
6 is hereby repealed.
