STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Overset pond, so-called, in the town of Greenwood, in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or 2 kill any kind of fish at any time from September first of each 3 year to June first of the following year, in Overset pond, 4 so-called, in the town of Greenwood, in Oxford County. 5 During open season on this pond it shall be unlawful for 6 any one person in any one day to catch and kill more than 7 five trout and land-locked salmon in all in said pond.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act 2 shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the

3 general law of the State for the illegal fishing for and catch-4 ing trout and land-locked salmon.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal and 2 police courts and trial justices in their respective counties 3 shall have, by complaint, original and concurrent jurisdiction 4 with the supreme and superior courts, and all fines, for-5 feitures and penalties received for any violation of this act 6 shall be paid forthwith by the person receiving the same 7 to the State Treasurer, and credited to fines and license fees 8 for the protection of birds and game. ,
