
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing below Upper Dam, so-called, in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
- 2 kill any kind of fish at any time in the pools from and below
- 3 the dam to the big rock at the mouth of the river, at Up-
- 4 per Dam, so-called, in Oxford County, except in the ordinary
- 5 way of casting with artificial flies or fly fishing.
- Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
- 2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in
- 3 the general law of the State for the illegal fishing for and
- 4 catching trout and land-locked salmon.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions arising under this act, muni-2 cipal and police courts and trial justices in their respective 3 counties shall have upon complaint, original and concur-4 rent jurisdiction with the supreme and superior courts, and 5 all fines, forfeitures and penalties received for any violation 6 of this act shall be paid forthwith by the person receiving 7 the same to the State Treasurer, and credited to fines and 8 license fees for the protection of birds and game.
