IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE

AN ACT regulating the open season on deer on Swan's Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. There shall be an open season on deer on
2 Swan's Island for one week in each year beginning the
3 first day of December, during which time it shall be lawful
4 to hunt, chase, catch, kill and destroy deer in accordance
5 with the general law of the State.

Sec. 2. Nothing in this act shall be construed as authoriz-
2 ing the hunting, chasing or killing of deer on Sunday, when
3 ever it occurs in the first week in December.

Sect. 3. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in

3 the general law of the State for the illegal hunting and kill-
4 ing of deer.

Sect. 4. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal and
2 police courts and trial justices within their respective coun-
3 ties shall have original and concurrent jurisdiction, upon
4 complaint, with the supreme and superior courts, and all
5 fines, forfeitures and penalties received for any violation
6 of this act shall be paid forthwith by the person receiving
7 the same to the State Treasurer, and credited to fines and
8 license fees for the protection of birds and game.
