STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate hunting in Back Bay, so-called, in Port-
land, in Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to hunt, chase, catch, kill
2 or destroy any wild birds or water fowl at any time in Back
3 Bay, so-called, in Portland, above the Grand Trunk Railway
4 bridge.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in
3 the general law of the State for the illegal hunting and
4 killing of game birds.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions arising under this act, muni-
2 cipal and police courts and trial justices, within their re-

3 spective counties, shall have, upon complaint, original and
4 concurrent jurisdiction with the supreme and superior courts,
5 and all fines, forfeitures and penalties received for any viola-
6 tion of this act shall be paid forthwith by the person re-
7 ceiving the same to the State Treasurer, and credited to
8 fines and license fees for the protection of birds and game.
