STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Thorndike to remove bodies
from abandoned cemeteries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The municipal officers of the town of Thorn-
2 dike are hereby granted authority to remove bodies from old
3 and abandoned cemeteries, within the limits of said town,
4 and to re-inter said bodies in the cemetery near the center
5 of said town; the expense thereof to be borne by said town.

Sect. 2. Said officers shall first ascertain and establish,
2 so far as reasonably possible, the identity of each body so
3 removed, including the name, age and approximate date of
4 burial, and upon re-interment shall mark or describe the
5 place of re-interment. All facts so established shall be en-
6 tered upon the town records.
