IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to render valid the doings of the Monmouth Ridge
Cemetery Association.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. "The incorporation of Monmouth Ridge Cemetery Association of Monmouth, County of Kennebec, State of Maine, as a Cemetery Association under the laws of said State, is hereby made and declared to be valid, and all the acts and doings of said Cemetery Association as a corporation are hereby legalized and made valid, and the record of its corporate acts signed by its secretary, is hereby ratified, confirmed and declared to be legal and valid."
