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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT relating to pleading a discharge in bankruptcy.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. A discharge in bankruptcy may be pleaded by  
2 a simple averment that on the day of its date such discharge  
3 was granted to the bankrupt, and a certificate of such dis-  
4 charge under seal of the Court granting the same, shall be  
5 conclusive evidence in favor of such bankrupt of the fact  
6 and regularity of such discharge.
