IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend the Charter of the Bangor Railway and  
Electric Company.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The Bangor Railway and Electric Company is  
2 hereby authorized to convey to and supply the town of Or-  
3 rington in the county of Penobscot and the inhabitants  
4 thereof with water for domestic, sanitary and municipal pur-  
5 poses, including the extinguishment of fires, with all the  
6 rights, powers and privileges and subject to all the duties,  
7 restrictions and liabilities contained in the charter of said  
8 company, and acts additional thereto and amendatory thereof.

Sect. 2. For the purposes aforesaid said company is au-  
2 thorized to lay, construct and maintain its mains and pipes

3 under, in, through, along and across the highways, ways,  
4 streets and bridges in said town upon such reasonable con-  
5 ditions as the selectmen of said town may impose.

Sect. 3. Said company is authorized to make all necessary  
2 contracts with said town or with other corporations in said  
3 town and with the inhabitants therein for a supply of water  
4 for any of the purposes named in section one of this act.  
5 The town of Orrington is authorized to make contracts with  
6 said company for a supply of water for fire and other mu-  
7 nicipal purposes upon such terms as may be agreed upon by  
8 said town and said company.
