STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Bluehill Trust and Bank-
ing Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Blue-
2 hill Trust and Banking Company, which were granted by
3 chapter two hundred and seventy-two of the Private and
4 Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-five, and ex-
5 tended by chapter three hundred and ninety-one of the
6 Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-
7 seven, and further extended by chapter one hundred and
8 thirty of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred

9 and ninety-nine, and further extended by chapter three hun-
10 dred and fifty-six of the Private and Special Laws of nine-
11 teen hundred and one, and further extended and amended by
12 chapter three hundred and thirty-six of the Private and
13 Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three, and further ex-
14 tended by chapter two hundred and twenty of the Private
15 and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and five, and further
16 extended by chapter two hundred and eighty-five of the
17 Public Laws of nineteen hundred and seven, are hereby ex-
18 tended for one year; and the persons named in said act,
19 their associates and successors, shall have all the rights,
20 powers and privileges that were granted them by said act,
21 to be exercised in the same manner and for the same pur-
22 pose as specified in said act; provided, however that said
23 company shall actually commence business as a trust com-
24 pany within said one year.
