STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Cumberland Trust Com-
pany.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The charter of the Cumberland Trust Com-
pany with all the rights, powers and privileges thereof,
granted by chapter three hundred and sixty-seven of the
Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred one, and ex-
tended by chapter thirty-one of the Private and Special Laws
of nineteen hundred three, and further extended by chapter
one hundred seventeen of the Private and Special Laws of
nineteen hundred five, and further extended by chapter two

9 hundred eighty-six of the Private and Special Laws of
10 nineteen hundred seven, is hereby extended for one year,
11 and the persons named therein, their associates and suc-
12 scssors, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges grant-
13 ed by said act, to be exercised in the same manner and for
14 the same purpose as specified therein; provided, however,
15 that said company shall actually commence business as a
16 trust company within said one year.
