IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter three hundred and fifty-six of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and seven, entitled "An Act to regulate the taking of white perch in Lake Sebasticook, in the town of Newport, county of Penobscot, and its tributaries."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Section one of chapter three hundred and fifty2 six of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred
3 and seven is hereby amended by striking out the word
4 "June" in the fourth line of said section, and substituting
5 therefor the word 'July,' so that said section as amended
6 shall read as follows:

'Section 1. There shall be an annual close time on white 8 perch in Lake Sebasticook, in the town of Newport, county 9 of Penobscot, and in its tributaries, from the first day of 10 April to the first day of July of each year, during which 11 close time it shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch, or 12 kill any white perch.

'Provided, further, that during the open season of each 14 year it shall be unlawful for one person to take, catch, kill, 15 or have in possession, more than eight pounds of white 16 perch in one day, taken from said lake, and only for con-17 sumption in his own family.'
