IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to prohibit ice fishing in Ware pond, in Lee, in
Penobscot county

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for,
2 take, catch or kill any kind of fish through the ice in Ware
3 pond, so called, in Lee, in Penobscot county, under the same
4 penalty as is provided in the general law of the State for
5 the illegal fishing for and catching trout and landlocked
6 salmon.

Sect. 2. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal and
2 police courts and trial justices within their respective coun-
3 ties, shall have, upon complaint, original and concurrent

4 jurisdiction with the supreme and superior courts, and all
5 fines, forfeitures and penalties received for violation of
6 this act shall be paid forthwith by the person receiving the
7 same to the State treasurer, and credited to fines and license
8 fees for the protection of birds and game.
