STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to prohibit ice fishing in the Prestile Stream in Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or 2 kill any trout in Prestile stream which flows through the 3 towns of Westfield, Mars Hill, Blaine and Bridgewater, or

- 4 any of the tributaries thereof in the said towns or in any
- 5 ponds flowing into said stream from October first to May
- 6 first of the following year for a period of five years from
- 7 October first, nineteen hundred and nine.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this 2 act shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten nor more

- 3 than thirty dollars and costs for each offense, and a further
- 4 penalty of one dollar for each such fish caught, taken or
- 5 killed in violation of this act.
- Sect. 3. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal and
- 2 police courts and trial justices, within their respective coun-
- 3 ties, shall have, upon complaint, original and concurrent
- 4 jurisdiction with the supreme and superior courts, and all
- 5 fines, forfeitures and penalties received for violation of
- 6 this act shall be paid forthwith by the person receiving
- 7 the same to the State treasurer, and credited to fines and
- 8 license fees for the protection of birds and game.
