STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT for the protection of deer in Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. There shall be an annual close time for deer,
2 during which it shall be unlawful to hunt, take, catch, kill or
3 destroy any deer, in the county of Cumberland, from De-
4 cember first to October thirty-first, inclusive, following of
5 each year. It shall be unlawful to hunt, chase, catch or kill
6 more than one deer in said county during the month of No-
7 vember in each year and it shall be unlawful to have in pos-
8 session in one open season more than one deer which has
9 been killed in said county.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act
2 shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the gen-
3 eral law of the State for illegal hunting, chasing, killing and
4 having in possession of deer.

Sect. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act
2 are hereby repealed.
