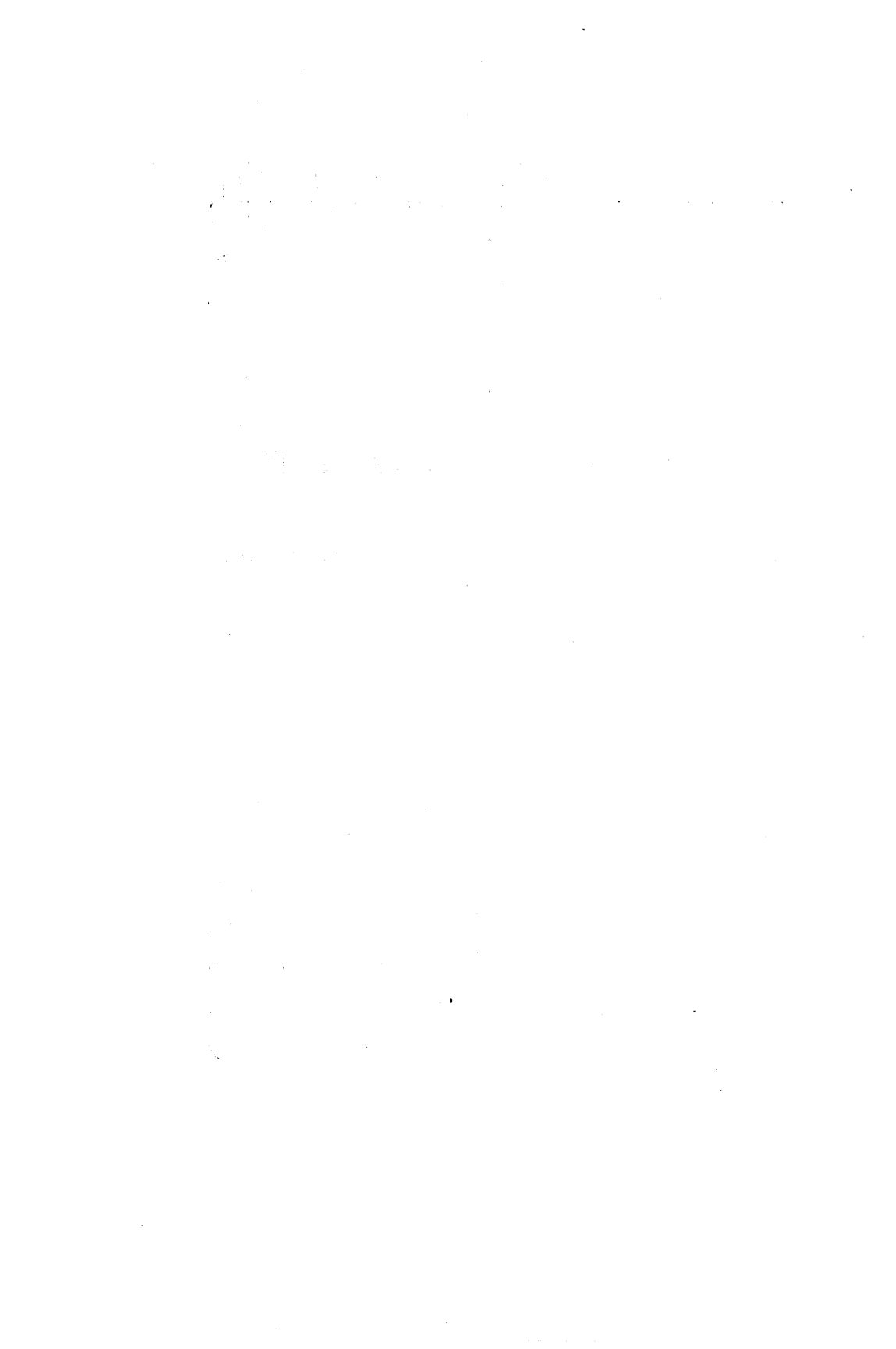
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to provide for ice fishing, in accordance with the
general law of the State, in Spectacle, the Stanleys, Trafton
and Jay Bird ponds, in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. So much of chapter 407, section 1, of the
2 Private and Special Laws of 1903, as closes Spectacle pond,
3 in Porter, and the Stanley ponds in Hiram, and Trafton
4 and Jay Bird ponds, Oxford county, to fishing through the
5 ice, as provided in the general law of the State, is hereby
6 repealed.
