IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to authorize and ratify the appointment of Portland
City Hall Building Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The order and action of the city council of the
2 City of Portland constituting Adam P. Leighton, John F. A.
3 Merrill and Richard C. Payson and their successors as there-
4 in specified, and any succeeding mayor of said city *ex officio*,
5 a commission to build a new city hall building and audi-
6 torium, together with the powers and duties enumerated in
7 said order, are hereby authorized and ratified. Said com-
8 mission may call and receive bids and proposals for erecting
9 said buildings, and in the name and on behalf of the city ex-

10 ecute such contracts therefor as the city council shall author-
11 ize, and shall see that the same are faithfully and promptly
12 performed. Money appropriated by said city council for
13 erecting said buildings shall be paid out only on the written
14 approval of said commission, or a majority thereof; and a
15 report of its work and expenditures shall be made at such
16 stated times as the city council may require. The members
17 of said commission shall receive only such compensation for
18 their services as said city council may vote.
