RESOLVE, in favor of Mary A. Goodwin of Kittery.

*Resolved,* That there be paid out of the State Treasury to  
2 Mary A. Goodwin of Kittery, County of York, a pension of  
3 six dollars per month, as the widow of Stephen C. Good-  
4 win, beginning January one, nineteen hundred and nine, to  
5 continue during the pleasure of the legislature.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Mary A. Goodwin, widow of Stephen C. Goodwin, is a resident of this town. She has a small place where she lives, on which she has been obliged to place a mortgage of \$500. Her condition is such that she is unable to do anything whatever for her support, and is entirely dependent upon others for same.
