AN ACT to set off from the town of Cushing in Knox County  
Fred Thornton, with his poll and estate and annex him with  
his poll and estate to the town of Thomaston in said Knox  
County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. That Fred Thornton with his poll and estate be  
2 set off from the town of Cushing in Knox County, and be  
3 annexed with his poll and estate to Thomaston in Knox  
4 County.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
