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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT to amend section two of chapter twenty-two of the Revised Statutes of the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and nine, relating to jail sentence for maintaining a liquor nuisance.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section two of chapter twenty-two of the Revised Statutes of the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and three is hereby amended by inserting after 4 "and" in the first line the words 'less than one hundred dol- 5 lars and.' Said section is further amended by striking out 6 the word "or" in the second line and inserting in its place 7 the word 'and.' Said section is further amended by in-

8 serring after the word "not" in the second line the words  
9 'less than thirty days and not,' so that said section as  
10 amended shall read as follows:

'Section 2. Whoever keeps or maintains such nuisance,  
12 shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars and not ex-  
13 ceeding one thousand dollars, and imprisonment in jail not  
14 less than thirty days and not more than one year.'
