STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of Israel H. Cross of Lincolnville.

Resolved: That there be paid to Abbie A. Cross, guardian
2 of Israel H. Cross, of Lincolnville, a pension of twelve dol-
3 lars per month, in lieu of his present pension of four dollars
4 per month. Said increase to commence January 1, 1909, and
5 to continue during the pleasure of the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Mr. Cross is at the present time an inmate of the Eastern Maine Insane Asylum at Bangor, his insanity having resulted from diseases contracted during his service in the Civil War. He was a member of Company B, 19th Regiment, Maine Volunteers. He has no relation capable of contributing to his support, and there is immediate and urgent necessity for the employment of a special male attendant, or otherwise to furnish the treatment and care that he requires. Letters from relatives and also the statement of the Selectmen of Lincolnville filed in connection with the granting of his original pension, also the statement of neighbors and friends of the family, show that this is a most deserving case.
