STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Chase brook and tributaries, and
in a portion of Fish River, in the County of Aroostook.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish at any time in Chase brook, so-called,
3 or in any of its tributaries, or in Fish river, so-called, from
4 Fish River Falls on said river to the mouth of said Chase
5 brook, all in the county of Aroostook. Whoever violates
6 any of the provisions of this section shall be subject to the
7 same penalty as is provided in the general law of the State
8 for illegal fishing for and catching trout and land-locked
9 salmon.

Sect. 2. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal and

2 police courts and trial justices within their respective coun-
3 ties, shall have, upon complaint, original and concurrent
4 jurisdiction with the supreme and superior courts, and all
5 fines, forfeitures and penalties received for violation of this
6 act shall be paid forthwith by the person receiving the same
7 to the State Treasurer, and credited to fines and license fees
8 for the protection of birds and game.
