AN ACT to restore Portland Bridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That the County Commissioners for the County of Cumberland be, and they are hereby, directed to restore in the City of Portland a bridge of steel or other material over and across Commercial Street from York Street, on Brackett Street, to the draw on Portland Bridge, with suitable approaches thereto, using so much of the highway and approaches to said Portland Bridge as may be necessary. Said bridge shall be built of such width and materials and in such manner as the County Commissioners shall determine that the interests of the public will best be subserved. Said bridge when completed shall be suitable for all purposes of ordinary travel between the cities of Portland and South Portland.
