IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter ninety-six of the Private and Special Laws of 1905.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter ninety-six of the pri-

- 2 vate and special laws of nineteen hundred and five is hereby
- 3 amended by striking out the words "in the waters or" in
- 4 lines one and two of said section, so that said section as
- 5 amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. No person or persons shall deposit upon the

- 7 banks of the Aroostook river, within the limits of the Fort
- 8 Fairfield village corporation, as now defined by law, any
- o garbage or refuse or waste matter arising or produced from
- 10 the cleaning up of yards, streets, grounds, stores, stables, or

11 other buildings; nor shall any person or persons deposit in 12 the waters or upon the banks of the Aroostook river, within 13 the limits of the Fort Fairfield village corporation, as now 14 defined by law, any dead animal of any kind.

This act shall not apply to sewage nor to pumace from 16 starch factories.
