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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT additional to Chapter 49 of the Revised Statutes, to  
better protect the interests of accident and health insurance  
policyholders.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. No company, stock, mutual or assessment, au-  
2 thorized to write Accident or Health Insurance shall be  
3 licensed by the Insurance Commissioner to transact busi-  
4 ness in the State of Maine which issues any policy or certifi-  
5 cate to a resident of Maine where the payment of a policy  
6 or entrance fee is required, or which makes any agency  
7 agreement or contract with a resident of the State of Maine  
8 on any kind of a profit sharing basis unless such agreement  
9 or contract specifically forbids such agent assisting in any

10 way in the investigation, adjustment or settlement of its  
11 losses, and any company which after being licensed violates  
12 the conditions of this act shall have its license revoked im-  
13 mediately and shall not again be licensed for five years.
