AN ACT relating to Police Court of the City of Belfast.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be the duty of the County Commission-
2 ers of Waldo County to furnish blanks, stationery, and blank
3 books of record, necessary for the use of the police court
4 of the City of Belfast, and the same shall be paid for out
5 of the county treasury of said County of Waldo.
