## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONF THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter one hundred and eighty-three of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and seven, relating to time of payment of members of the government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and eighty-

- 2 three of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and seven is
- 3 hereby amended by striking out the word "fifty" in the
- 4 twenty-fifth line and inserting therein the words "one hun-
- 5 dred," so that said section, beginning at the twenty-first line
- 6 thereof shall read as follows:

'Each member of the Senate and House of Representa-

8 tives shall receive three hundred dollars for the regular ses-

9 sion of the Legislature, and two dollars for every ten miles to travelled, from his place of abode, once in each session. He is entitled to mileage on the first day of the session, and 20 one hundred dollars of his salary on the first day of each 3 month thereafter, during the session, and the balance at the end thereof; but two dollars shall be deducted from the pay 15 of every member for each day that he is absent from his duties, without being excused by the house to which he be-
