STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT authorizing Plantation of Monhegan to issue bonds
to raise money to pay the cost of building a Town Landing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Plantation of Monhegan is hereby au-
2 thorized and empowered to issue and sell its bonds to an
3 amount sufficient to procure funds to pay the cost of a town
4 landing already built on the shore of the harbor of said
5 plantation, and not exceeding twenty-five hundred dollars,
6 in accordance with a vote passed in said plantation at a legal
7 special plantation meeting held May first one thousand nine
8 hundred and eight.

Sect. 2. All acts, doings and votes passed at said planta-
2 tion meeting relative to said landing, and all bonds hereto-

3 fore issued and sold by said plantation for the purpose, and
4 under the vote, mentioned in the preceding section, are here-
5 by ratified, confirmed and made legal.
