AN ACT to make valid, the doings of the Town of Bristol, in
the County of Lincoln.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The doings of the inhabitants of the town of
2 Bristol, in the County of Lincoln, at their annual meeting,
3 held on the fourth day of March, 1907, and at all subsequent
4 meetings, are hereby confirmed and made valid.
