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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT to amend Section 25 of Chapter 129 of the Revised  
Statutes, relating to the sale or use of cigarettes.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section twenty-five of chapter one hundred and  
2 twenty-nine of the revised statutes is hereby amended by  
3 inserting after the words "or gives away" in the third line,  
4 the words 'or in any way obtains for,' also by inserting after  
5 the words "any cigarette" in the third and fourth lines, the  
6 words 'cigarette paper, so-called, or tobacco used for making  
7 any cigarette,' so that said section as amended shall read as  
8 follows:

'Sect. 25. Whoever by himself, clerk, servant or agent,

10 directly or indirectly, sells, offers for sale, has in his pos-  
11 session with intent to sell, or gives away to, or in any way  
12 obtains for any person under the age of twenty-one years,  
13 any cigarette, cigarette paper so-called, or tobacco such as  
14 is used for making any cigarette, shall be punished by a  
15 fine not exceeding fifty dollars or by imprisonment not ex-  
16 ceeding sixty days. Trial justices and municipal and police  
17 courts shall have jurisdiction of offences arising under this  
18 section.'
